[PROPERTIES]

Source: Polyclonal antibody preparation

Host: Rabbit

Purification: Antigen-specific affinity chromatography followed by Protein A affinity chromatography

Traits: Liquid

Concentration: 0.39mg/ml

Applications: WB; IHC; ICC; IP.

[IMMUNOGEN]

Immunogen: Recombinant GP1Bb (Phe53~Arg176 (Accession # P56400)) expressed in *E.coli*

[APPLICATIONS]

Western blotting: 0.5-2µg/mL;1:200-800

Immunohistochemistry: 5-20µg/mL;1:20-80

Immunocytochemistry: 5-20µg/mL;1:20-80

Optimal working dilutions must be determined by end user.

[FORMULATION]

Form & Buffer: Supplied as solution form in 0.01M PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.05% Proclin-300, 50% glycerol.

[STORAGE AND STABILITY]

Storage: Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Store at 4°C for frequent use.

Aliquot and store at -20°C for 12 months.

Stability Test: The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the

expiration date under appropriate storage condition.

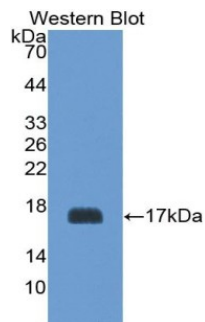


Figure. Western Blot; Sample:
